You must have the correct Gender, Age, and Level before selecting a team.

Usually, you do not have to worry about the Gender, Age, and Level, because they remain defaulted to your previous game.

For boys and girls youth hockey, select “Youth”

You may have multiple teams from the same community...all using the same community name. First you select the Gender, Age, and Level and then you select the community name.

This allows you to have various teams with unique rosters from the same community like:

- St. Cloud Boys High School
- St. Cloud Girls High School
- St. Cloud Bantam AA
- St. Cloud PeeWee B2
- St. Cloud Squirt C
- Etc.

In the Teams Window, you would only list “St. Cloud” as the available team
